The 4-H Apple Pie Contest Scholarship will be based totally on 4-H Experiences and Community Service. Only one scholarship from the 4-H Advisory Committee Scholarship, 4-H Apple Pie Contest Scholarship, and Ohio Valley Bank 4-H Scholarship will be awarded to an individual.

HOW THE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE PAID

After the scholarship winner is chosen, the money will be paid upon the winner showing a receipt of enrollment in college or technical school within one academic year of the scholarship award.

The first priority of funds shall be for tuition, books and laboratory fees. If the student fails to complete the work for which the scholarship is granted, he/she is expected to repay the amount of money awarded to the applicant.
