- Sex of the animal
- Birthdate of the animal
- Breed
- Photo of the pair of birds



4-H Online Animal ID Help Sheet

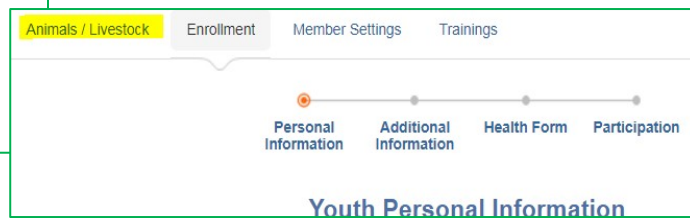
- Every animal that may be taken to the fair **MUST** be identified in oh.4honline.com by **June 1st**.
- Please complete the following steps through 4-H Online to add EACH animal's information.

STEP 1

1. Log into oh.4honline.com
2. Click "I have a profile"
3. Enter your email and password from enrollment
4. Make sure your role is set to "family"
5. Hit the Login button
6. On the next screen select 

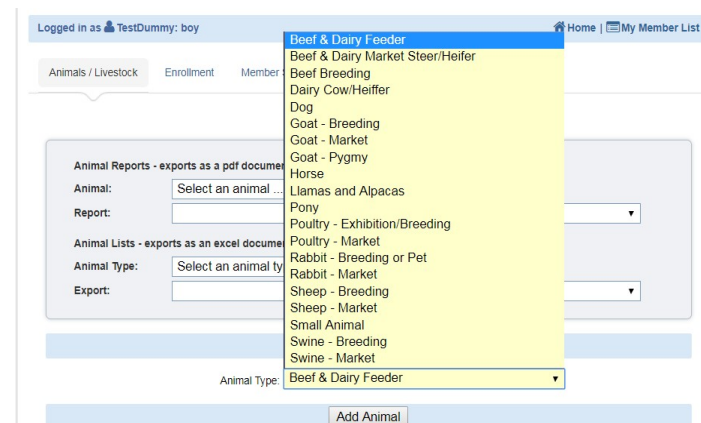
STEP 2

1. You should see a list of family members enrolled; choose a family member by selecting 
2. Click on Animals/Livestock tab at top left  above Youth Personal Information.



STEP 3

1. Now that you are on the "Animals/Livestock" page, you will see a heading in light blue that says "Add an Animal"
2. Click on the drop-down menu and choose the type of livestock you want to add.
3. Select the gray button "Add Animal"



STEP 4

1. Follow the instruction on the next page of this handout.

FANCY POULTRY: Entering your animal's information

- Each space with an arrow pointing to it is a required field.
 - For Breeder Name, enter N/A (not applicable)
 - For all other fields, enter your animal's information.

- **CAUTION: MAKE SURE ALL INFORMATION IS COMPLETE AND ACCURATE!** You cannot edit the information once you hit save. If you make a mistake and hit save – you will need to create a duplicate animal to make the correction. In the identifier or tag number field for the duplicate (correct) animal – put an asterisk * or say “correct one.”

Fancy Poultry

- One entry consists of two chickens, one male and one female, of the same breed and variety.

Ducks and Geese

- An entry of breeding ducks or geese should consist of one male and one female.
- An entry of meat ducks or geese will consist of two males.

Turkey

- An entry of breeding turkeys should consist of one male and one female.
- An entry of meat turkeys will consist of two males.

Because we are unable to view your animal at a face-to-face tag-in, you must upload pictures of your animal. These pictures will be matched to your animal when it is brought to the Pike County Fair weigh-in.
