

Rules of the Dairy Goat/Cow/Heifer Lease Agreement

1. To be valid, the agreement must be signed by owner, 4-H/FFA member, and parent/guardian. Upon signatures of all parties involved, this lease agreement is subject to the following rules.
2. The term of the lease will be the date the legal owner signs the form, until the end of the project year.
3. During the term of the agreement the animal is a 4-H/FFA project. The 4-H/FFA member must keep a project record book.
4. The 4-H/FFA member must agree to physically care for this animal to the fullest extent possible. A care schedule will be worked out between the owner of the animal and the 4-H/FFA member. (The attached 4-H/FFA and Owner(s) responsibility's form **must** be completed.)
5. **NO** animal substitutions may be made between the first Saturday in May and conclusion of the 4-H/FFA project year.
6. The Owner(S) agrees **NOT** to sell the animal after signing the agreement before the end of the project year.
7. It is understood and agreed that the 4-H/FFA member leasing the goat(s) will be held responsible for any injury caused to or by the member, third party, the goat(s) while under members' care.
8. If any of the listed conditions are violated by the 4-H/FFA member or family of the owner(s) has the right to break the lease and reassume care for the animal(s).
9. The member must abide by all 4-H/FFA rules, policies, and requirements for specific animal projects.
10. To be eligible for the lease program, a 4-H/FFA member must not currently own (or purchase within the current project year) a dairy goat/cow/heifer.
11. A leased animal may only be leased by one Ohio junior fair exhibitor.

This agreement is to be completed and submitted to OSU Extension, Pike County by the current year tag-in/ID date (First Saturday in May). Lease agreements will be reviewed and verified by the Pike County Junior Fair Superintendents.

The Pike County Fair Board, Barn Superintendents, and OSU Extension are not responsible for settling disagreements, legal responsibilities, or injuries between the lease, or injuries between the lessee (4-H/FFA member) and the recorded owner(s).
