

8. Perform a 360 degree turn to the right, walk out of box and to finish




Show Date: 07/29 & 30/2023



2. Flat or show walk from C to the Judge.
3. Stop and set up for inspection.
4. When dismissed, perform a 180 degree turn.
5. Running walk or pleasure gait straight away from the Judge.


Show Date: 07/29 & 30/2023
