PIKE COUNTY JUNIOR FAIR BOARD CONSTIUTION AND BY-LAWS

CONSTITUTION

- 1) The advisors of the Junior Fair Board will be appointed by the Senior Fair Board and will include the following representation: one Senior Fair Board member, one County Extension personnel, and two appointed advisors.
- 2) There will be a minimum of fifteen (15) and a maximum of thirty (30) members elected for Junior Fair Board. They may be selected from the following youth organizations: 4-H, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, FFA and FCCLA. The number of members from each youth organization will be contingent upon active county enrollment in that organization.
- 3) The officers elected will be President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Publicity Chairman.
- 4) The new term for all members will begin in October and end in September.
- 5) Regular meeting dates for the year will be set at the first regular meeting. Special meetings may be called at any time.
- 6) The officers will be elected at the discretion of the advisors, not to be elected later than the January meeting.
- 7) In order to be eligible for the Junior Fair Board, youth must have successfully completed the 8th grade, and have not passed their nineteenth (19th) birthday as of January 1, current year. Youth must complete a Junior Fair Board application, submitted to Pike County Junior Fair Board Advisors (311 Mill Street, Piketon, OH 45661) by the assigned deadline.

BY-LAWS

- 1) There must be a majority of members present to add, change, or delete any new laws to this constitution.
- 2) All terms are one (1) year. Members must reapply each year. The selection process will be determined by the Junior Fair Board Advisors.
- 3) The Junior Fair Board Advisors have the final approval of all members.
- 4) All members must attend at least six (6) meetings and participate in 1 fundraiser each year. Members can only have 3 unexcused absences. The member must be in attendance for at least 20 minutes of each meeting to be counted present. The result of not complying with this rule shall be in the dismissal of that member by the advisors.

5) Officers:

- The President should attend and preside over all meetings, keep order and select various committees.
- The Vice-President will have the same duties as the president if the president is absent from the meeting.
- The Secretary is responsible for keeping attendance and accurate minutes of every meeting.
- The Treasurer must keep complete and accurate records at all times.
 The treasury will also be audited once a year in September. Two signatures will be required on all checks.
- The Publicity Chairman will be responsible for all publicity of the Junior Fair Board including the Royalty contest.
- If you are an elected officer and unable to attend the meeting, it is your responsibility to contact with the advisors.
- 6) If a member of the Junior Fair Board is employed, he/she must be free to perform assigned duties at the fair. Assignments will be based upon project responsibilities.
- 7) Jr. Fair Board members must adhere to dress code, when representing the fair board at shows and events. Short must be at least fingertip length. Shirts must cover the entire upper body, (no deep plunged neckline, bare midriff, etc.). No t-shirts with inappropriate sayings or political slogans.
