4-H member.

1. Follow and complete the Guidelines on Page 2 of the project book.
 - a. Level 1: 10-13 years old – complete all activities
 - b. Level 2: 13 years and older or member taking project for second year – complete all Level 1 and 2 activities.
2. Create an educational exhibit or poster describing some aspect of your project.
3. Bring to Interview Judging:
 - a. Neat and complete project book as per Guidelines.
 - b. Be prepared to discuss information presented in the book, knowledge obtained from your record keeping, and what you learned from the activities you completed.
 - c. Level 1
 - i. Money Journal, Page 13.
 - ii. Advertising Activity, Page 14.
 - iii. Any additional/optional activities you completed.
 - d. Level 2
 - i. All Level 1 activities as listed above.
 - ii. One of the options listed on Page 31 under “to accompany my money plan.”
 - e. Educational exhibit or poster
4. Exhibit in club's fair booth if you and your advisor so choose:
 - a. The educational exhibit or poster presented at Interview Judging. (Project book **does not** qualify as an exhibit.)
