

540 Not Just Knots

1. Complete project book, including all 17 Activities (include Capstone) and all Talking It Over questions (as outlined on pages 4-5)
 - a. Complete at least two (2) Learning Experiences.
 - b. Complete at least two (2) Leadership/Citizenship activities.
2. Create a display board as follows:
 - a. A minimum of six (6) knots displayed on the board.
 - b. All knots are to be properly labeled, neat and readable from a distance of 10 feet. Be able to explain the use of these knots.
 - c. Member's name and club are to be visible on the front of board.
3. Know how to tie three (3) different knots and be ready to demonstrate.
4. **SECOND YEAR:** Make a product from rope.
5. Bring to Interview Judging:
 - a. Neatly completed project book.
 - b. Display board.
 - c. Bring your own rope, 6' long manila or sisal, and know how to tie three (3) different knots and be ready to demonstrate.
 - d. For SECOND YEAR project: Bring a product you have made from rope.
 - e. Be prepared to discuss any information from the project book.
 - f. Know the 4-H Pledge, 4-H Motto, and 4-H Colors.
6. Exhibit in club's fair booth if you and your advisor so choose:
 - a. The display board presented at Interview Judging and item made from rope (second year only). (Project book **does not** qualify as an exhibit.)

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
