## 584 Photography Basics - Book 1

1. Complete Steps 1, 2, 3, and 4 as outlined on page 3 in project book.

## 2. Bring to Interview Judging:

- a. Neat and complete project book.
- b. A display representing their learning experience of the current project.
- c. All mounted prints must be identified by printing class #, member's name, and county in lower right-hand corner on the back of the exhibit.
- d. Each participant is required to bring one of the following three items for exhibit:
  - A single print of any size mounted at the discretion of the participant; or
  - A collection of prints illustrating a "Photo Story", consisting of at least five and not more than ten photographs mounted at the discretion of the exhibitor; or
  - A collection of prints illustrating one of the "activities" the participant completed for the project, consisting of at least five and not more than ten photographs, mounted at the discretion of the participant.

Participants may also bring any other materials they feel might demonstrate their learning experiences from the current project year (although participants are not required to do so). Photochemical developing and printing may be done by the participant but is not required.

3. Exhibit in your club's fair booth, if you and your leader so choose.
