## **617 Exploring Ponds**

This advanced-level project is for members who are experienced in exploring the outdoors and who want to learn more about ponds. Youth take a look at the "big picture" of Earth's water cycle and water conservation, and then look closely at a pond's health and its ability to support the organisms in and around it. Projects are eligible for state fair on Natural Resources Day II.

- 1. Read the project book.
- 2. Follow and complete Project Guidelines as detailed on pages 4-7 in project book. Get help from parents, advisor, or others if needed.
- 3. Complete an education display or poster from Interview Judging describing some aspect of the project.
- 4. Bring to Interview Judging:
  - a. Neat and complete project book.
  - b. Be able to discuss any information from the project book.
  - c. An exhibit or poster.
  - d. Know the 4-H Pledge, 4-H Motto, and 4-H Colors.
- 5. Exhibit in club's fair booth if you and your advisor so choose:
  - a. An education display or poster from Interview Judging describing some aspect of the project. Project book **does not** qualify as an exhibit.
