

621 Ohio Birds

1. Follow and complete the General Project Guidelines as indicated on Pages 1-5 of project book.
2. Create a loose-leaf notebook with 30 pictures of the birds you have seen and pictures of 10 nests – do not collect nests. You may take your own photographs, cut out pictures from magazines, or draw and neatly color each bird seen. Also include any pictures of bird feeders or field trips you have taken.
3. Make a bird feeder.
4. Neatly print or type a report summarizing your project learning experience.
5. Bring to Interview Judging:
 - a. Neat and complete project book.
 - b. Be able to discuss any information from the project book.
 - c. Your notebook and report.
 - d. Know the 4-H Pledge, 4-H Motto, and 4-H Colors.
6. Exhibit in club's fair booth if you and your advisor so choose:
 - a. Your notebook opened at page illustrating and describing some aspect of project. Mounted and labeled photographs or bird feeder.

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
