630 Safe Use of Guns

Beginner Level, ages 9-14

A beginning level project designed as a one-time experience for ages 9-14. Older youth with no experience or limited knowledge of guns may also begin this project. A parent/guardian must supervise any 4-H member who chooses to take this project.

- 1. Read and understand the project book.
- Read and sign the safety pledge on page 3.
- 3. Complete the Project Guidelines and Project Activities as detailed on page 4.
- 4. Take part in at least two (2) Project Learning Experiences and report on what you did (complete Page 5).
- 5. Become involved in at least two (2) Leadership/Citizenship activities and report what you completed (complete Page 6).
- 6. Write a one-page report (Page 7) describing what was done and learned through this project.
- Create an educational exhibit or poster illustrating or describing some aspect of your project.
- 8. Bring to Interview Judging:
 - a. Neat and complete project book.
 - b. Be able to discuss any information from the project book.
 - c. Project Learning Experiences and Leadership/Citizenship reports
 - d. One-page project report.
 - e. Educational exhibit or poster.
 - f. Know the 4-H Pledge, 4-H Motto, and 4-H Colors.
 - g. No type of gun and/or weapon is to be brought to Interview Judging!
- 9. Exhibit at the fair, if your club leader chooses!
 - a. Educational exhibit or poster from Interview Judging illustrating and describing some aspect of project.
 - b. No type of gun and/or weapon is to be displayed at fair!
