1. Complete the **Project Guidelines** as outlined on page 5 of project book.
2. Complete the Shooting Practice Log on Page 37. (Targets from at least three shooting sessions will be needed for Interview Judging.)
3. Create an archery scrapbook including archery safety guidelines.
4. Create an educational poster illustrating and describing the following parts:
 - a. Point
 - b. Shaft
 - c. Crest
 - d. Fletching
 - e. Feather or vanes
 - f. Nock (arrow & bow)
 - g. Tip
 - h. Back
 - i. Face
 - j. Arrow rest
 - k. Bowstring
 - l. Nocking Point
 - m. Handle
 - n. Also include types of bows (compound, recurve, longbow), and arrows (target, field, broad head, and judo heads).
5. Bring to Interview Judging:
 - a. Neat and complete project book.
 - b. Be able to discuss any information from the project book.
 - c. Shooting Practice Log (Page 37) and at least three (3) targets from shooting sessions.
 - d. Archery scrapbook.
 - e. Educational poster.
 - f. Know the 4-H Pledge, 4-H Motto, and 4-H Colors.
 - g. **Bows and arrows are not to be brought to Interview Judging!**
6. Exhibit in club's fair booth if you and your advisor so choose:
 - a. Educational poster from Interview Judging illustrating and describing some aspect of project.
 - b. Archery scrapbook from Interview Judging.
 - c. **Bows and arrows are not to be displayed at fair!**

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
