The **Person in Charge** training enhances employee understanding of major food safety principles: time and temperature abuse, crosscontamination, and personal hygiene. The program includes a National Restaurant Association Education Foundation Handbook, several hand-on activities and a Certificate of Completion.

Person in Charge training is a one-day basic food safety training which meets ODH **Level 1 Training Requirements** for food service employees and those opening an establishment for the first time.
